

**OUR LADY OF FATIMA SCHOOL
ENRICHMENT PROGRAM
PIANO INSTRUCTION**

Piano lessons are offered to students in Kindergarten through 8th grade. Students will be required to have a piano in their home throughout the year and to practice regularly. There will be a minimum of 30 lessons during the school year, 30 minutes in length once a week. The lessons will replace either a vocal music class or a PE class. Students will receive a private 30 minute lesson once a week.

Tuition is \$550.00 for the year and is payable in one of three plans:

- A. Registration of \$55 with balance due on September 1st.**
- B. Registration of \$55 with balance due in two equal installments of \$247.50 each due September 1st and February 1st.**
- C. Registration of \$55 with monthly payments of \$55 due the 1st of each month beginning September 1st through May 1st.**
