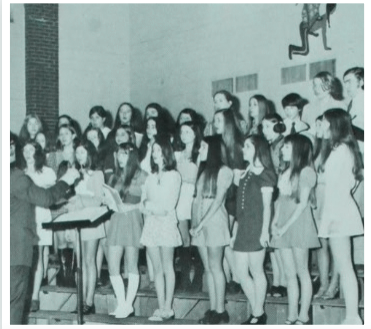
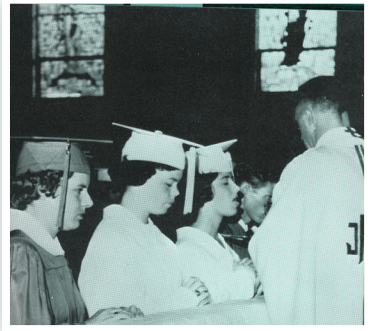

After a year of team-building and spirited fellowship, we are proud to announce the winning house for the fourth year in a row: ONRAKA! Congratulations to all members of the winning house!





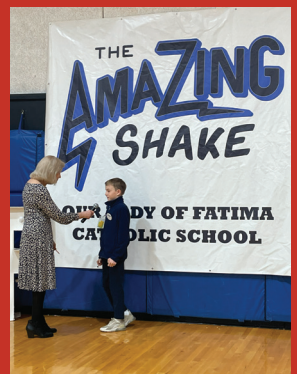
Polished & Prepared for the Future

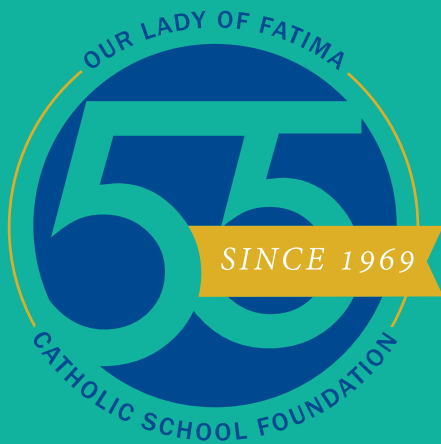

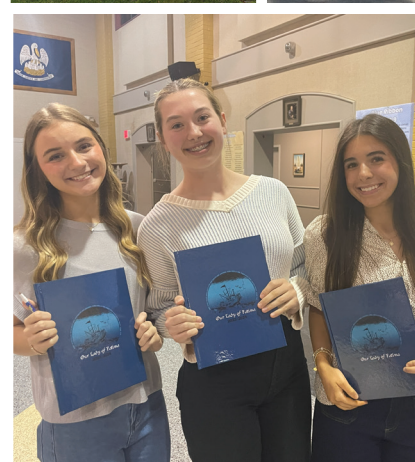

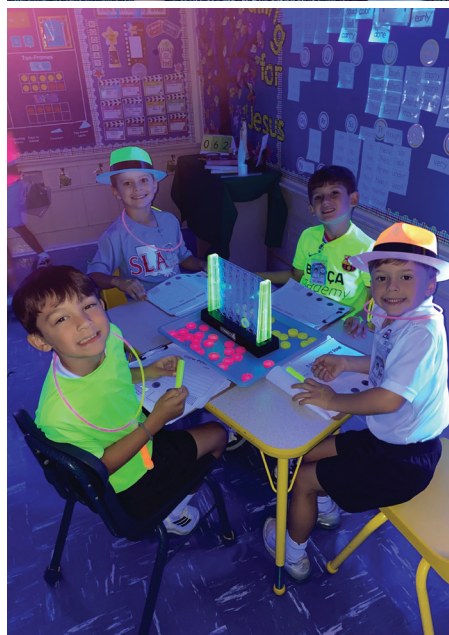
