1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

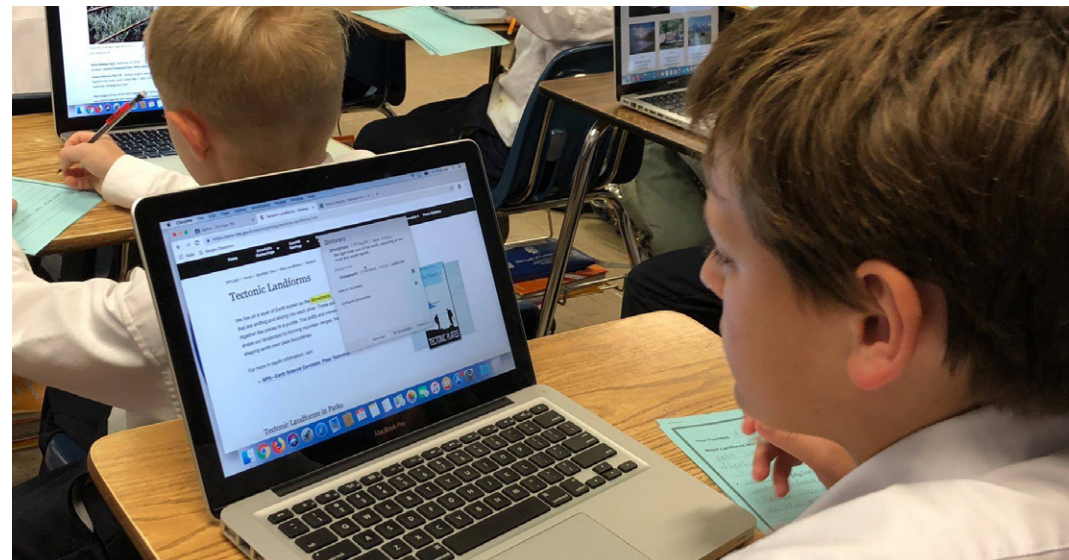
**REJOICE ALWAYS, PRAY CONTINUALLY, GIVE THANKS IN ALL CIRCUMSTANCES;

## THE OLF FOUNDATION CELEBRATES 50 YEARS!

The Our Lady of Fatima Foundation has been in existence for 50 years. We dedicate this annual report to the Foundation and their 50 years of supporting the school. In this half century, the Foundation has given the school over \$2,400,000 in earnings. Without the Foundation, those funds would have been collected through tuition.

Simply put, the endowment is a pool of funds raised by the OLFS Foundation, which is then invested and provides returns or ongoing income to the school, either for tuition grants to needy families or for general operating support. Currently, the Foundation endowment is at \$2,700,000 and growing.

## ENDOWMENT BENEFITS TO THE SCHOOL

1. Help defray major tuition increases
2. Provide tuition grants to families and alumni in need
3. Keep teacher pay as close as possible to Lafayette Parish teachers and ensure that they are among the best paid in the Diocese
4. Help the school offset its operating budget
5. Keep class size at 12 in Pre-K 3, 18-20 in Pre-K4 and 21-24 per class in K-8.

Our Best Kept Secret!

It all started in 1969 when a group associated with Our Lady of Fatima Parish and School came together and formed the Our Lady of Fatima School Foundation under the direction of then pastor Msgr. Rudolph Arlanti. Their idea was to raise a significant amount of money, invest it wisely in an endowment account and use the income from the account to assist the School with its finances. Flash forward to today and the Foundation's endowment balance is nearly \$2.7 million. And, in fulfilling the wishes of its incorporators, the Foundation has distributed nearly \$2.4 million of earnings to Our Lady of Fatima School, much of it for technology needs.

My history with Fatima started in 1953 when I entered kindergarten. In 1966, I graduated from Our Lady of Fatima High School. All four of my daughters attended Fatima and I now have four grandchildren enrolled. My wife, Linda worked at Fatima School for twenty-one years and I serve as a trustee of the Parish and have served on the Foundation board for nearly forty years. Our family is part of the Fatima family and the Fatima family is an integral part of our family. I have supported the Foundation for many years and continue to do so for the difference it makes in the lives of our Fatima family; our pastor, parishioners, administration, staff, teachers, and especially our children.

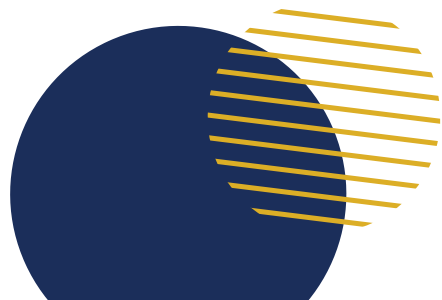






## SUPPORTERS AND DONORS

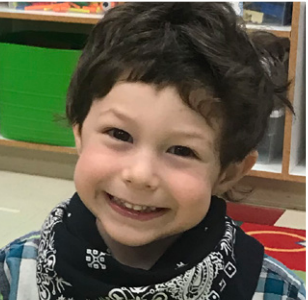
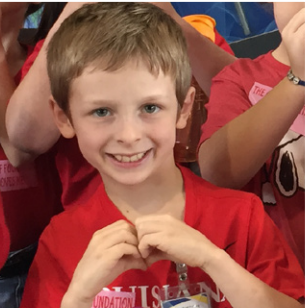
