GUIDELINES

- Keep your students home if they are sick or have a fever
- Follow doctor's orders
- No school temperature checks
- Masks are required for Kindergarten through 8th graders and all adults
- Wash/sanitize hands-on arrival when entering a room, bathroom breaks, before and
- Each student should bring their own water bottle and water fountains will remain closed
- No social distancing requirements
- No static groups
- Junior High classes mix and change classes (students will line up single file, and move in one direction)
- Junior High students will have access to lockers
- Self-monitor and report symptoms to the school nurse
- Before School Care will begin at 7:00 am. Registration required via Google form sent 8/8/21.
- Continue isolation areas as needed
- High-touch surfaces will be cleaned a minimum of two times a day
- Bathrooms will be cleaned a minimum of two times a day
- Dismissal All students will be dismissed from Chance Hall



VISITORS

- Self-assess symptoms using the Health Screening Form before visiting campus
- Sanitize hands
- Drop-off and Pick-up
 - Carline will continue to flow through the Cabbage Patch
 - o Parents may park on side streets and walk students in and out of campus in the morning and afternoon
 - The parking lot is reserved for faculty, staff, and PK3 parents
 - Please be mindful and limit time and crowding on campus, in classrooms, and Chance Hall during drop off and pickup
- Campus visits should generally be limited to outdoors



POSITIVE CASES

- Students and teachers who test positive should isolate for 10 days and return on day 11 if symptom-free.
- A general letter will be sent to a class when a positive case is reported
- If exposed, no quarantine is required with vaccination
- A class will go virtual with 25% or 5 positives
- All cases in students and their families must be reported to the school nurse, Elyse Tatford, who will give quarantine instructions.
