# 2023-2024 ACCELERATED READER OLF Library Challenges & Classroom Requirements

## Library Challenges

The OLF Library AR Incentive Program is designed with <u>optional</u> challenges for students to go above and beyond what is already expected of them in the classroom. What students do beyond that, to challenge themselves, will be recognized and rewarded by the library.





#### <u>Goal Getters</u>

Students that reach their goal by mid-quarter (AR Goal Getter Deadline set on school calendar) with an 85% or better comprehension average will earn an invitation to the AR quarterly treat pickup at a designated lunch.

#### Point Clubs

Students that strive to enter point clubs, to be recognized throughout the year, will be treated to incentives each quarter.



Each grade level is given a starting point in the Point Club Challenge.

2nd/3rd grade - 15 Point Club \* 4th/5th grade - 25 Point Club \* Jr High - 50 Point Club Point clubs continue beyond 50 points. Students can move through one or more clubs per quarter. (75, 100, 150, 200, 300, 400, 500, 750, 1000).

Students notify the library of their point club accomplishment via Google Form in order to be recognized and rewarded.

#### **MillionAiRes**

Students who read one million words or more will join the MillionAiRe Club.

These students will be awarded a swag bag of goodies and a MillionAiRe yard sign for bragging. In addition, for each one million words read, their name will go into the MillionAiRe Raffle to win a prize at the end of the school year.



#### <u>Top Readers</u>

At the end of the school year, the top 5 students who have earned the most AR points in their grade level while maintaining an 85% or better comprehension average will receive the AR Top 5 Award.

## <u>AR Classroom Requirements</u>

Classroom expectations of the OLF AR Program are for students to meet individualized reading goals and maintain an 85% or better comprehension average on AR quizzes taken. Each quarter, students are given individualized AR point goals based upon the ZPD ranges generated from the STAR tests taken at the beginning, middle and end of the school year. To help students meet these expectations and improve their reading and comprehension skills, they may select and read a variety of AR books of interest within their ZPD ranges (outside of range allowed with teacher's permission) and test on them at school. At the end of each quarter, an AR grade is calculated reflecting the students progress towards reaching the classroom expectations. The AR grade breakdown per grade level is as follows:

The student must meet both goals to earn this grade.</li> <li>10/10</li> <li>If both goals are not met, the student is not penalized for this.</li> <li>An overall <u>20 point</u> AR "reflective" grade will be issued in the <u>3rd &amp; 4th quarters</u>.</li> <li>see 4th &amp; 5th grade</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>An AR <u>"incentive" grade</u> can be earned if:</li> <li>the student meets their AR Goal at the end each quarter. <ul> <li>10/10</li> </ul> </li> <li>If the point goal is not met, no AR "incentive" grade is issued. ### **Double Dipper Incentive**

Students that <u>double</u> their AR point goal (reach 200% or more of their goal) and maintain 85% or better comprehension average at quarter's end will receive <u>5 bonus points</u> added to the % of goal met grade.

• 3rd grade - (3rd & 4th quarters ONLY)
